Opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the 3rd Step Prayer.

GENERAL REPORT: All subcommittees are on schedule as per their timelines. Entertainment is working with the activities subcommittee of GOASCNA and looking into a softball tournament.

PLEASE TELL YOUR GROUPS THAT THE HOTEL AT UNITY WILL BE NON SMOKING. What that means is that smokers will not be allowed to smoke under the roof of the hotel. You will be allowed to smoke at the pool, the pool terrace and the parking lot. You will be responsible to use the butt cans **and** clean up behind ourselves. **We will not be asked back if we don't and it will be difficult to find another hotel for future functions if we are not responsible at this one !!!!**

Secretary, Program committee Vice chair and members, Registration Committee Vice Chair and members, Merchandise Vice Chair, Fun Raising and Entertainment Vice Chair, Marathon Vice Chair. **IF WE DO NOT GET VICE-CHAIRS FOR OUR SUBCOMMITTEES IT IS NOT LIKELY THAT THERE WILL BE A COU 26 SINCE NO ONE WILL BE TRAINED TO STEP UP.** It should seem obvious that this convention needs support, it feels to some of us that you all want to have a convention, but it is up to US to put it on and we are almost "willing it" to happen. Does this area want these conventions? If so we suggest that you look at the second concept again and ask your home group members to step up!!!! **We need them to be involved in the subcommittees, and also to pre-register.** We believe the best way that can happen is that all here take the leadership role you have assumed and lead by example, get involved....PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE

Registration has completed the search for the commemorative medallion and it has been ordered. Merchandise has ordered the shirts. **IF you want to be assured of getting convention shirts we urge you to preorder those shirts. To be sure we don't over order merchandise we are ordering much less than we did last year. There are men's and women's polo shirts which will only be available by preordering them. If you do not preorder your convention merchandise please don't complain if there is none left. It is your responsibility to announce this to your home groups.**

Since the motion to have the convention every 5 years failed and since 10 groups voted against that motion, we expect at least one member of each of those home groups to serve this convention in one form or another. Actually, we would like to see everyone who voted against having a convention every 5 years serve by either joining a subcommittee, or maybe even stepping up to the plate and becoming a vice chair or alternate secretary. In the very least we expect those people to sign up for a shift in the Hospitality Suite, Chair a marathon meeting, or become a Serenity Keeper. If you and your home groups are not willing to do this, we would expect you to make a motion to reconsider the 5 years convention. It is time you put your bodies where your mouths are, it is easy to decide that "we" should have a convention every year, and then let "them" put it on. If you note some frustration in this report, you would be right. We have been asking and even begging for YOUR involvement in YOUR convention and when that has not been forthcoming we had at least hoped you would allow us to not be responsible past this year for UNITY, since you have done neither, you will have to indulge us our concern about those of you who tell OTHERS what to do, but are too "busy" to commit to doing anything you ask us to do yourselves, you know who you are.

We were disappointed that you, the ASC, did not choose to take advantage of the opportunity to tour the Hotel at the last ASC, it further underlines your lack of interest in supporting Unity or getting involved. It is difficult for the members of this subcommittee to maintain the passion and commitment necessary to put on a convention in the face of such apathy, but to their credit the members of this host committee are continuing to do so; we applaud them for their commitment.

We have selected the Saturday night Speaker for Unity and are proud to announce that to celebrate our 25th anniversary, we have selected Bob B. from California. World Convention in San Diego to honor the 50th anniversary Of Narcotics Anonymous.

Bay Area : Annual "Leap of faith" free campout at Boyd Hill Nature Park in St. Petersburg. Feb.23-25 starts at 4PM Friday...(BASCNA.ORG for more info).

Big Bend Area : 12 home groups with 23 meetings per week.

Chain O' Lakes Area : 9 home groups with 15 meetings per week.

Daytona Area : Convention April 27-29 Plaza Resort Daytona Beach. Possible merging of PR/Helpline.

First Coast Area : Verbal report on the floor no mayor issues.

Forest Area : 8 home groups 104 monthly meetings. 2 H & I presentations weekly. (forestareana.org).

Heartland Area : 25 home groups, 50 weekly meetings. 36 H & I presentations monthly.

Palm Coast Area : 49 groups meeting 74 times per week. H & I with 108 presentations into 20 facilities. Successful 25th Convention with more than \$2,000.00 to area.

Recovery Coast Area : 13 groups with 15 weekly meetings. H & I has 6 presentations.

River Coast Area : 12 groups and 20 meetings weekly. H & I has 3 presentations. Annual Floral Fry on April 7th (RiverCoastAreaNA.org).

Space Coast Area : 6 groups and 29 meetings weekly. H & I carried 23 to 25 meetings monthly in one Treatment Center and 2 in one Corrections Facility. STACNA II March30- April 1st.

Suncoast Area : 38 groups, with 50 weekly meetings. H & I taking 8 presentations to 7 facilities weekly.

Tampa Funcoast Area : 62 groups, with 92 weekly meetings. The 2006 monthly average to operate the Helpline was \$243.00. The monthly cost of phones was \$89.97. H & I with 36 Presentations into 9 institutions. **A continued lack of respect and disrespectful Behavior from trusted servants has continued. They are looking for experience strength and hope from the body.**

Treasure Coast Area : 39 meetings. H & I is carrying 37 meetings into institutions. STACNA II March30-April 1.

Uncoast : 29 weekly meetings and 5 H&I meetings. PR/Helpline sub-committees have merged. Activities Will be putting on a Red and White Ball on Feb.17, also UCACNA hosting a dance, "Dance Until You Turn Green!", same night.

Regional Subcommittee Reports:

Ad-Hoc Reports

Fellowship Development : Dealing with struggling areas with a shortage of Trusted Servants to cover all subcommittees' chairs.

Helpline : 9 areas attended the helpline sub-committee meeting.

H&I : 16 areas attended. Out of the Areas reporting, we are carrying 573 presentations into 126 facilities and 23 contacts. Daytona Area is having some difficulties implementing their new screening process for juvenile facilities. Due to the new process, they have lost a facility. As soon as the current policy was passed the Panel Coordinator and entire panel stepped down.

Lit Input & review : Basic Text review period ends on February 28th .

Public Relations: 13 members in attendance. 7 written reports were turned in.
